At the end of 2013, a group of students from the SIMC master's program at WU Vienna approached Nik Franke and me with the idea of organizing a startup conference. We were enthusiastic about such a student initiative right from the start and started sharing our views on the project. I can still remember that one meeting in January 2014 most clearly, when we drew up the outline of the whole event series and experienced this special "let's do this" moment.

Since then, Entrepreneurship Avenue has grown amazingly, exceeding our wildest expectations. Since its premiere in spring 2014, over 15,000 students from more than 125 universities and nations have taken part. More than 430 student start-up teams were formed and supported.

All the while, each vintage of organizing teams has brought their own ideas and views to enhance the program, without forgetting its purpose and roots: to help students from various disciplines and universities to experience the basics of entrepreneurship experientially, regardless of the end result.

In 2017, AACSB International, the world's largest education network, recognized Entrepreneurship Avenue "for its commitment to creating and incubating cutting-edge business innovation and fostering entrepreneurship in the next generation of leaders." Entrepreneurship Avenue received this award as the only European program out of 120 nominations worldwide.

Delivering a unique program requires a unique team and network. In this anniversary report, many people who care about Entrepreneurship Avenue have their say. I would like to thank all the pioneers and companions of the last few years: the student co-organizers, the faculty of the Institute for Entrepreneurship and Innovation and the WU Entrepreneurship Center, our contacts at the 28 partner universities of the ECN, all participants and startup teams and of course our great speakers, mentors, jury members as well as partners and sponsors. ABOUT ENTREPRENEURSHIP AVENUE



THE WHY

Universities can represent an abundant source of innovative business ideas. However, many fail at tapping into this huge entrepreneurial potential. The reasons for this are manifold. When designing the program we observed three prominent ones in particular:

There is a lack of entrepreneurial know-how: only a small share of students in Austria receive some kind of entrepreneurship education during their studies. As a result, there is a lack of awareness of entrepreneurship as a viable career path. And there is a lack of interconnection between disciplines/universities, although inter-disciplinarity represents a key success factor for innovative business ideas, in particular.



THE MISSION

The primary mission of the Entrepreneurship Avenue is to fill these gaps: it is a unique event series designed to inspire, encourage and support young people to start their own business. The program's uniqueness? It is open to students from all disciplines and universities. It is a platform of opportunities for students, both 'explorers' who simply want to learn about entrepreneurship and for 'wantrepreneurs' who benefit from the elaborate support infrastructure the program offers to student startup projects.

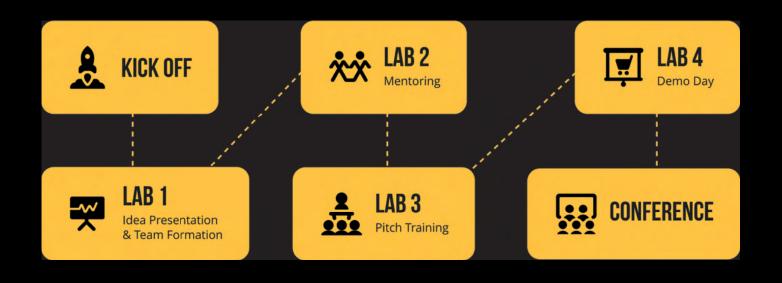


PROGRAMM DESIGN

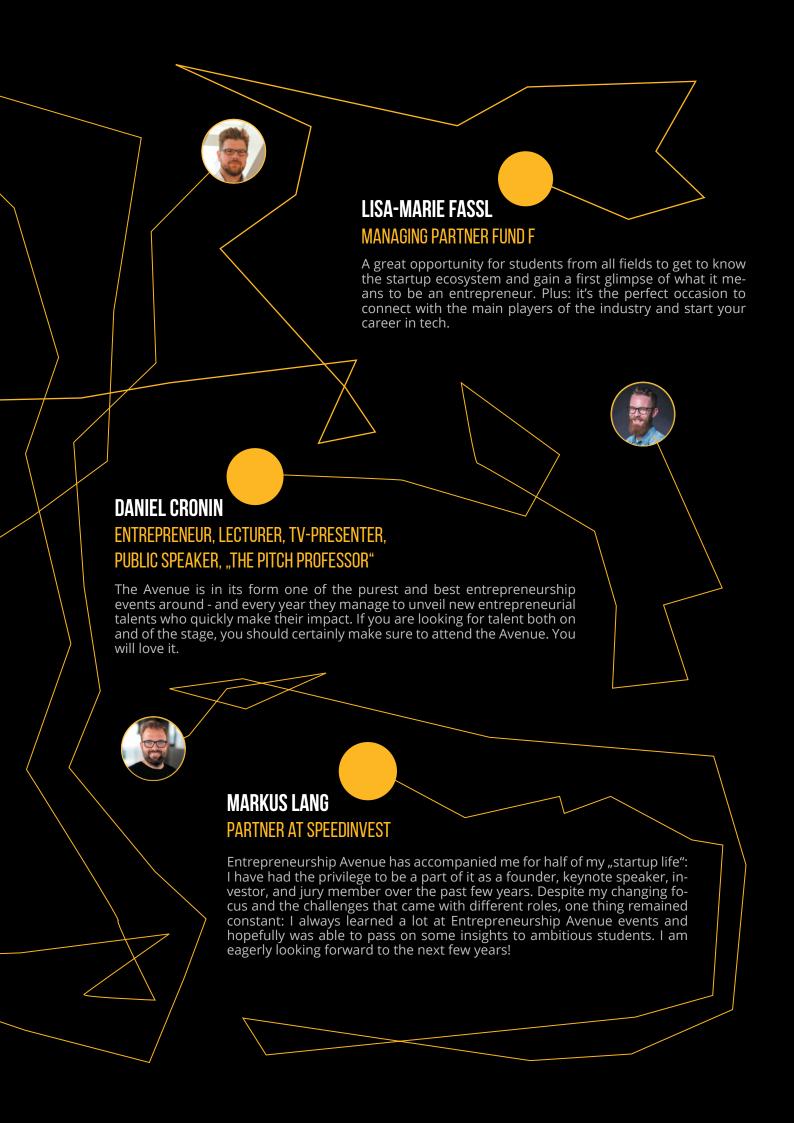

Deliberately seen as an experiment, the first Entrepreneurship Avenue was designed and implemented within just three months by a team of 15 WU students and faculty. With over 600 participants and 25 startup teams, expectations were exceeded right from the first edition!

2015

After the success of the first year, it was clear: Entrepreneurship Avenue is here to stay. In a strategy workshop with Frank Owen, the new organizational team developed the purpose and guiding beliefs of the program to lay the foundation for the coming years. The number of participants could be doubled.

2015

AACSB International, the world's largest education network, recognized Entrepreneurship Avenue as a best practice in entrepreneurship education. In 2016 there were three times as many participants as in 2014, and in 2017 four times as many students were part of the Avenue.

2020/2022

The organizing teams took on the Covid19 challenge in an entrepreneurial manner. They redesigned the Entrepreneurship Avenue into an all-online program in 2020 and realized that this changeover was not only a difficulty, but also brought with it many new opportunities. The Avenue became even more diverse and international than in previous years.

2018/2019

We reinforced the workshop series and the cross-university collaboration, also thanks to the ECN expansion.

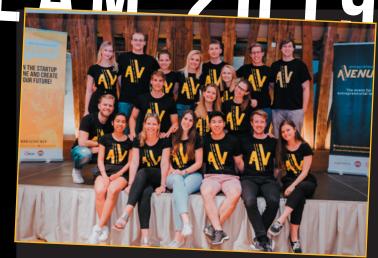
